Making a difference - Global Goals

This term, each class is planning an event, activity or campaign which 'makes a difference' to others and to the planet and is linked to the UN Global Sustainable Development Goals we learnt about in the Autumn term. We also created beautiful art work inspired by the goals, too.



In Year 2 we learnt about Global Goal 14 Life Below water which aims to preserve and protect plant and animal life under water. In Year 2 this term we will be completing a campaign to promote this goal!



In English this term, we will look at Poetry, Traditional Tales, Quest Stories, and Explanation Texts.

We will use mainly Little Red Riding Hood to inspire our own writing and will also be looking at Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers and rewriting our own ending to a quest story.

RE	We will be learning about The Five Pillars of Islam to begin the term. Then we will be learning about how Christians make promises to God The children will learn what the 10 Commandments are, how these are God's rules for living and Christians (and Jews) believe them to be rules that they are commanded to follow, and what the 10 Commandments teach about the nature of God.
Science SCENCE	Children will be learning about Animals including humans, Materials, Plants, and Living things and their habitats. We will focus on life processes, habitats, the basic parts of a plant, needs of plants, uses of everyday materials, and that some materials' shapes can be changed. We will carry out scientific enquiry into how bean plants grow in different conditions and finding out whether the change in materials' shape is permanent.
Computing	The children will complete some coding using Scratch Jr, using our coding skills from RodoCodo and Purple Mash, focusing on how to use and modify designs to create their own quiz questions and realise these designs using blocks of code.
PSHE	Our PSHE week takes place during the week commencing Monday 20 th May and will focus on the wider community and good citizenship. In Year 2 we will be learning about Money: where money comes from, what savings are and how we can save.
PE Tennis Basketball	This term Year 2 will be learning Athletics. We will be learning all fundamentals in athletics including, running, jumping and throwing culminating with our sports day at the end of the term.
Music	Come Dance With Me - This lively warm-up song works well with movement and provides a good springboard into composing new lyrics and actions. The call-and-response nature of the song translates well into instrumental work, with the children creating their own percussion responses and playing simple rhythm patterns on tuned instruments.
Art	Art will be linked to our different topics. Children will complete a range of pieces using different materials and techniques. We also plan to do small studies on different artists, including Henri Rousseau's 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm',looking at their practices and disciplines.
Design Technology	This term's DT project will be on the topic 'wheels and axles'. The children will investigate different uses and construction of wheels and axles, and will create their own toy vehicles. We will also be completing the spring DT, learning about how to make a healthy salad,
French	We will be continuing our introduction to basic French vocabulary through games, role play, stories and songs. We will be learning and practising vocabulary for greetings, numbers, likes and dislikes, colours and clothes.
