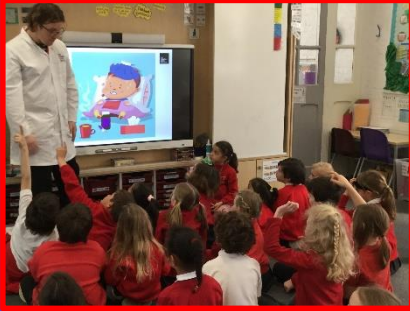
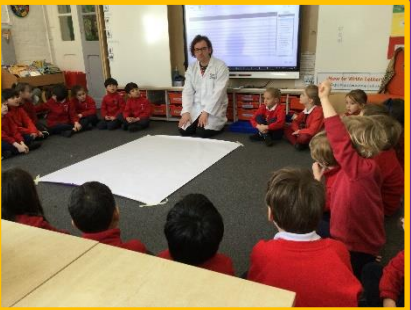
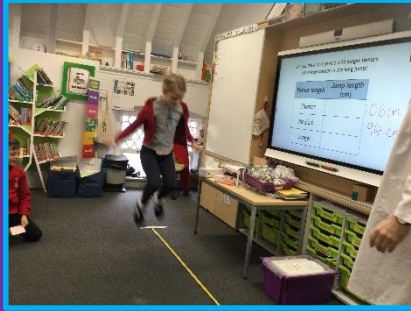


Year 1 used their senses so they could identify different objects. They also thought of adjectives to describe what they perceived using their senses.

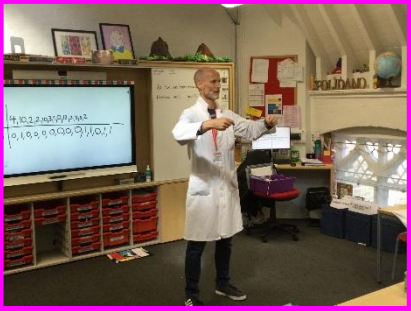


Year 2 learnt all about germs and what we can do to try to help stop the spread of them. Then, they looked through microscopes at different things in the classroom
