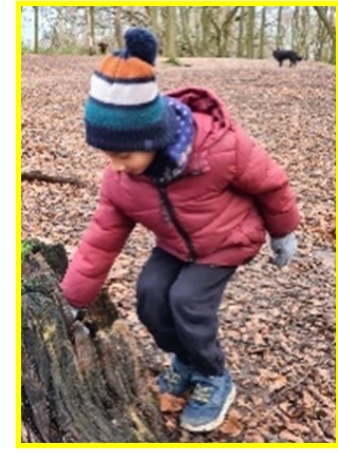


# Celebration Week
