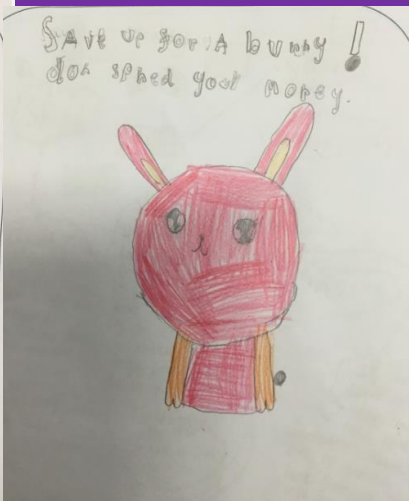
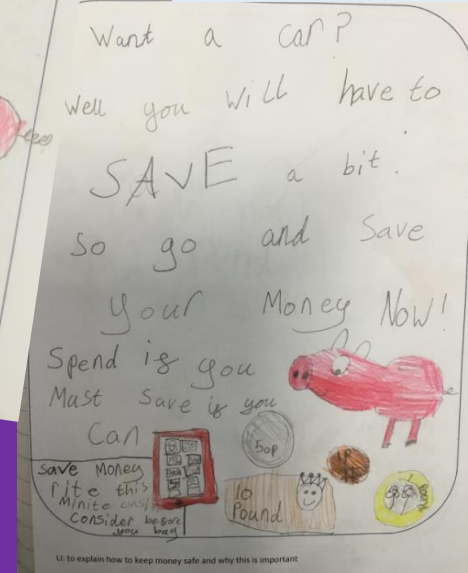
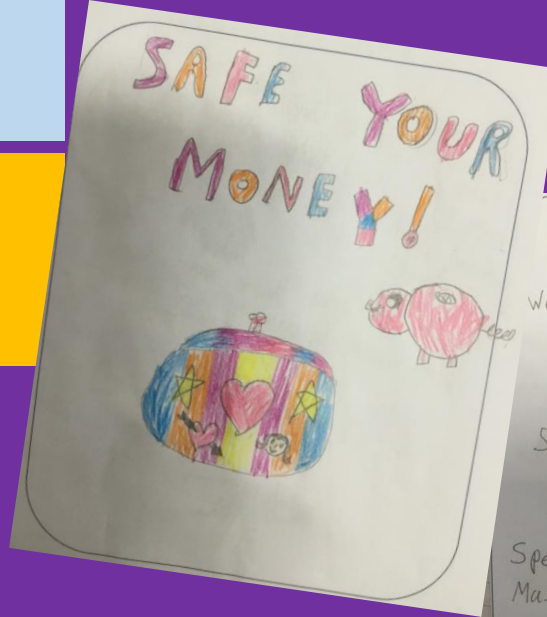


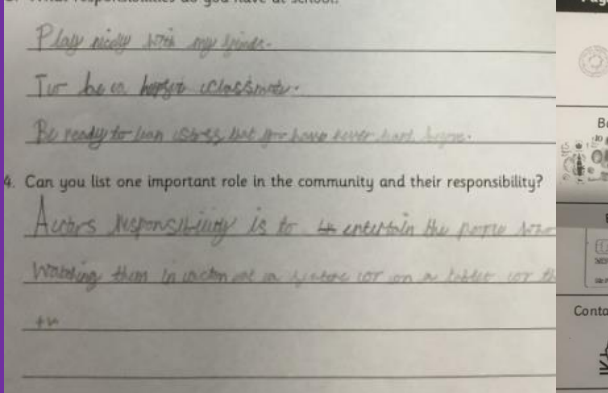
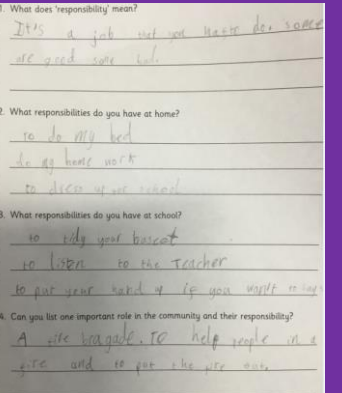
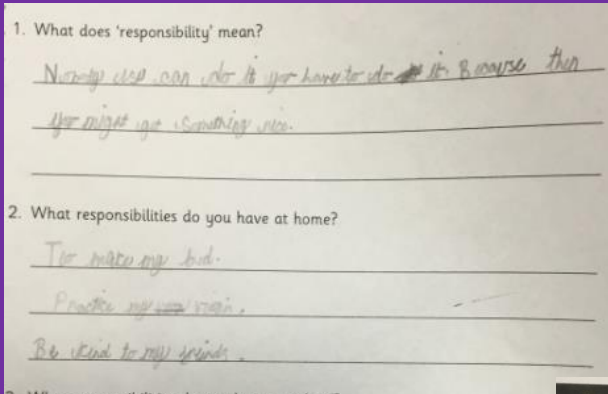
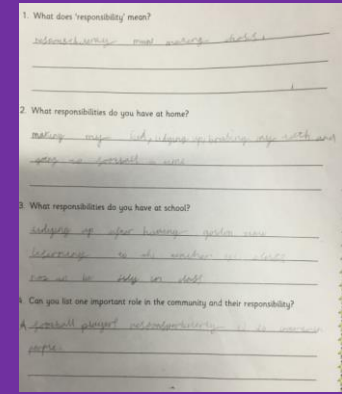
Living in the Wider World-Becoming an Active Citizen
