

Year 6 History Trip - British Museum - October 2024

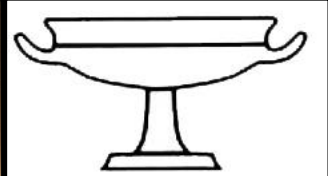
We visited the British Museum to build upon our history learning in school. We are learning all about the Ancient Greeks.

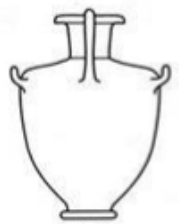

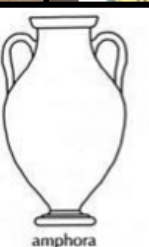
