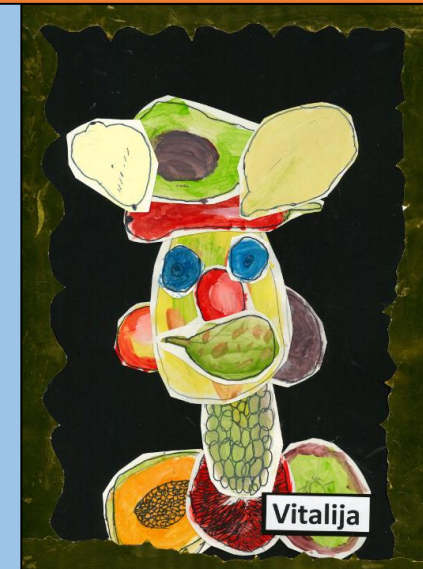
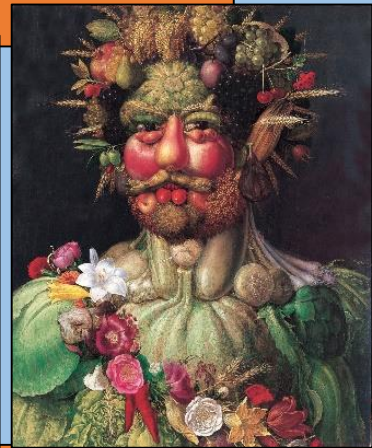


Year 2 CAP - Giuseppe Arcimboldo self-portraits
