

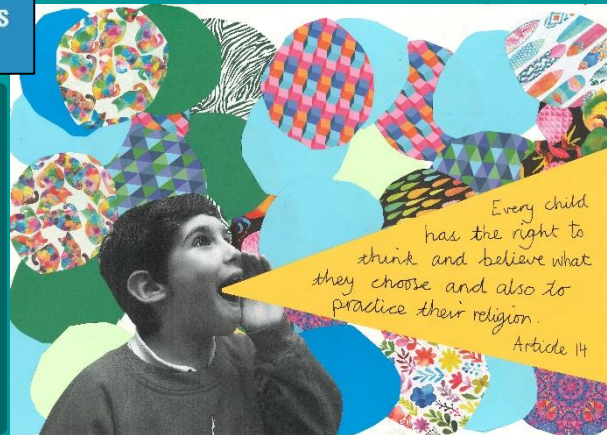
CAP – Article 12 Year 3
