SHARING THOUGHTS FREELY

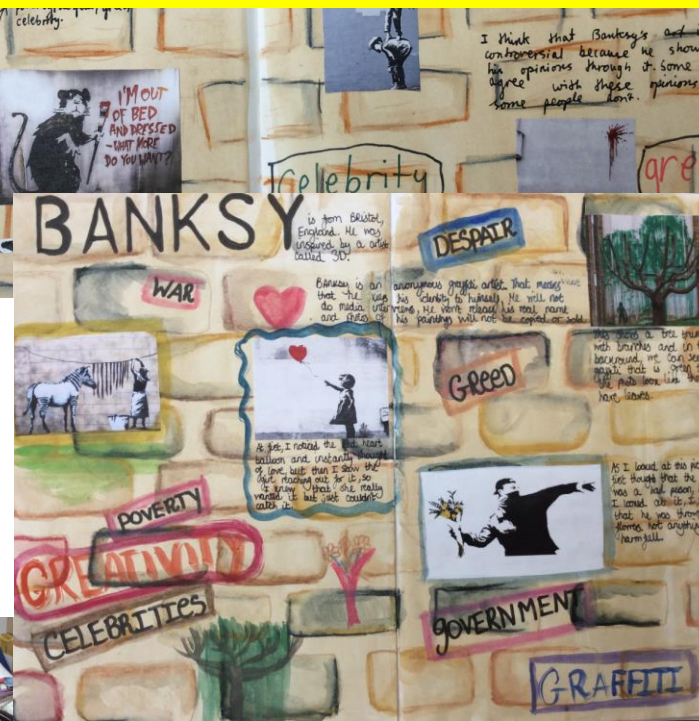

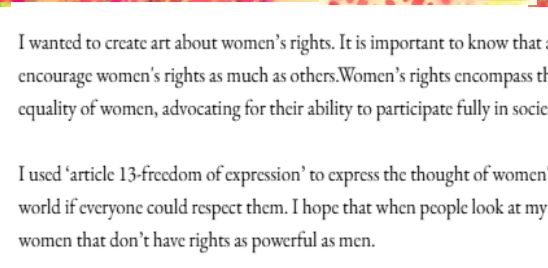
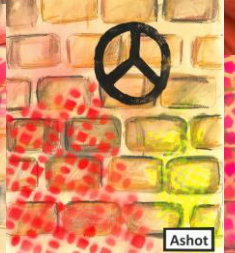
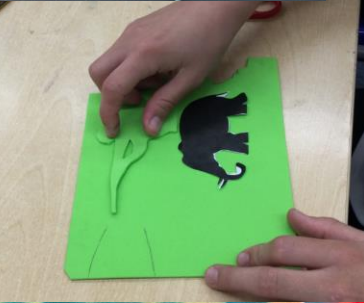
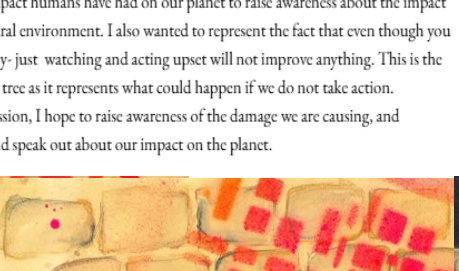
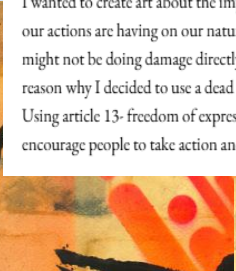
I hope that when people see this artwork, they think about all the animals that lose their homes because of us. I also hope that people reflect on their actions and understand how we are the reason for animal extinction.
