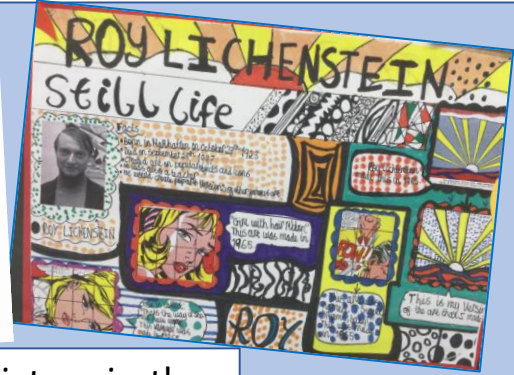
We loved your song about 'being the change' which linked so well to your geography learning!
