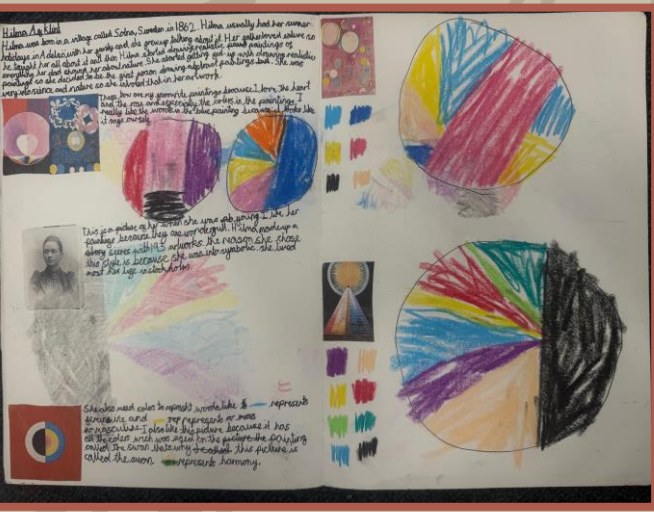
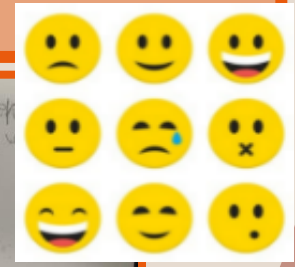
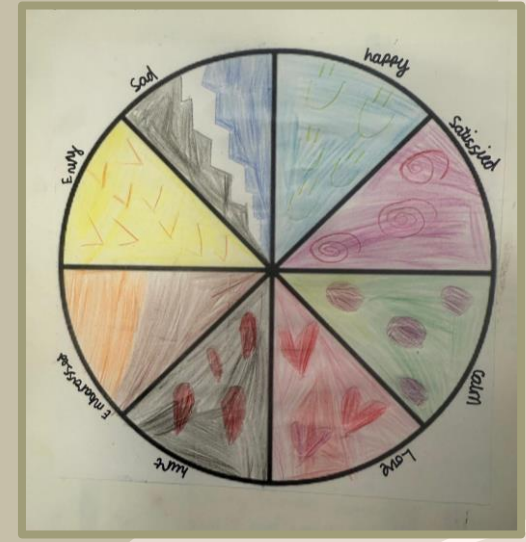
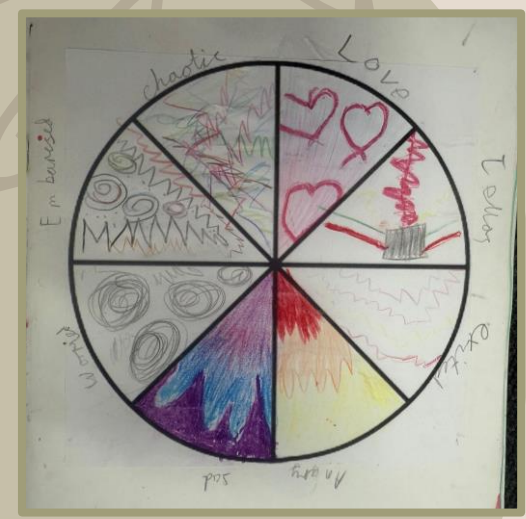


Year 4 CAP project Conveying Emotion Through Colour and Shape

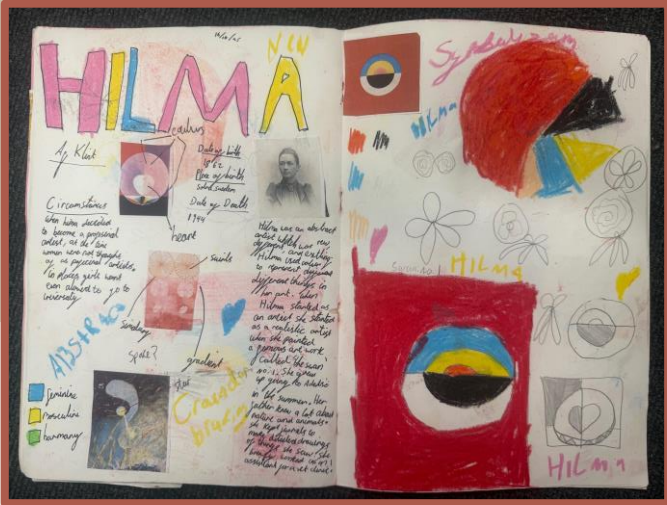
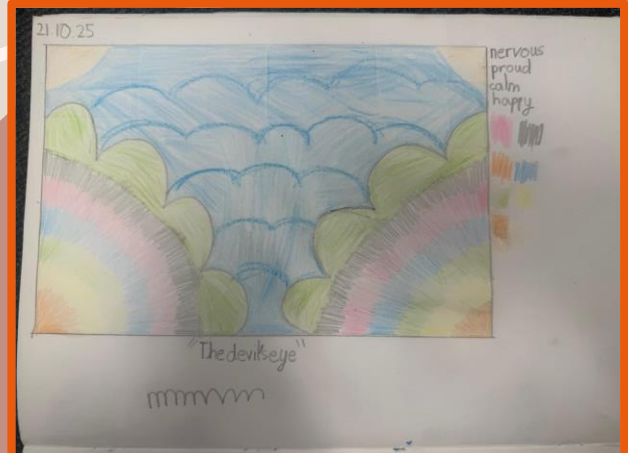
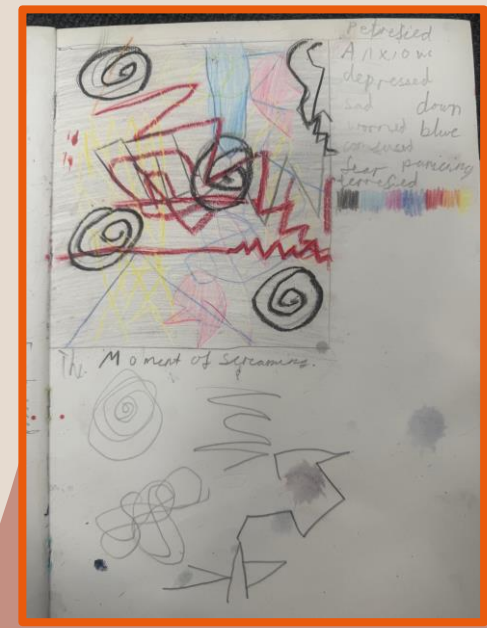
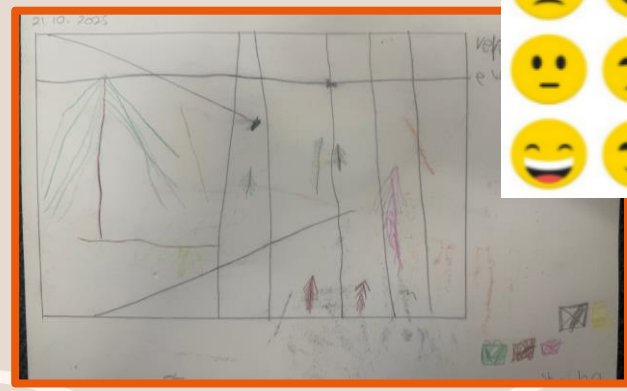

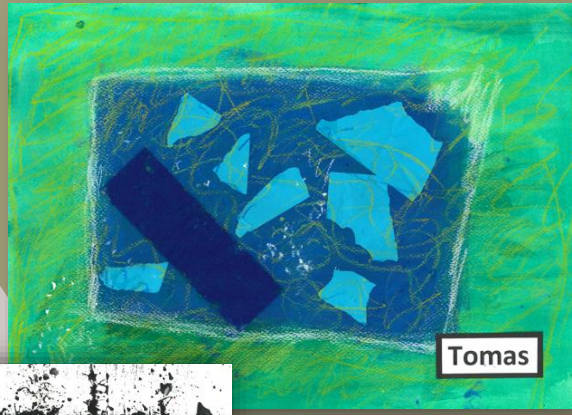


We learnt about Hilma Af Klint who used colour and shape to convey different emotions in her work. These are some of our artist studies on Hilma.

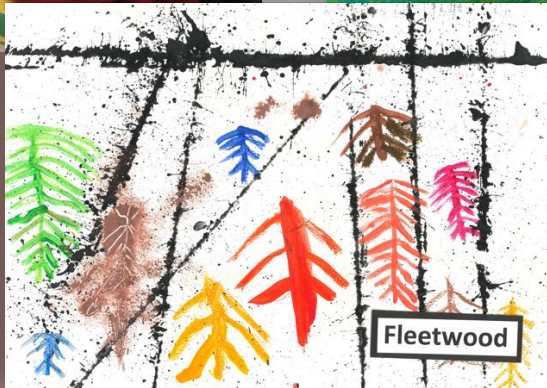


After learning about Hilma, we created our own emotions wheels, assigning our own colours and shapes to the emotions we selected. All of them looked very different, and were personal to each of us.
