



Year 6 CAP Autumn 2025



The Year 6 CAP project this term was based on our Happiness Project theme 'Friends and Family' and inspired by Faith Ringgold. Faith Ringgold is an African American artist who became famous for her innovative "story quilts". Each of these artworks, which are pieced together with painted canvas and fabric, tells a story. The quilts feature narrative images and texts handwritten on sections of fabric.

Year 6 were inspired, in particular, by her narrative quilts, where, through joining together panels of painted fabric, she tells stories which are important to her life story or cultural heritage.

Year 6 learnt about how important our connections to others are in order to support our well-being. Each member of Year 6 created a 'quilted' frame of tessellated hexagons, embellished with symbols, drawings and mark-making connected to their own friends and family using symbolism and then learnt to trace accurately to create an outline image from treasured photograph of friends or family for the centre.

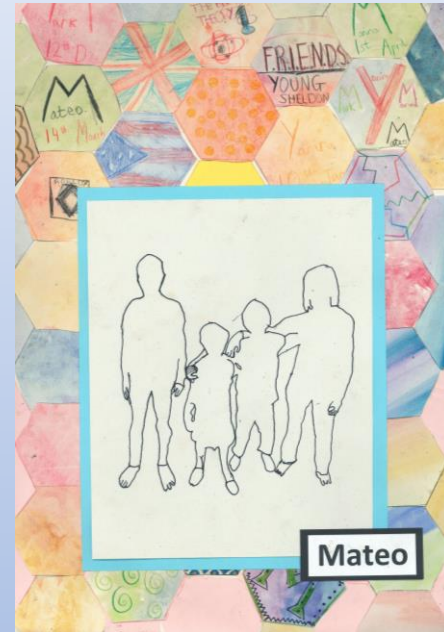
